

PETER K. SHAFFER

From the effects of an apoplectic stroke, Peter K. Shaffer died at his home in Elderton at 4:20 a.m. Thursday. He was the son of John and Harriet (Craig) Shaffer , and was born January 12, 1849, being 84 years, eleven months and 23 days old. Surviving are one daughter, Mrs. John Frailey of Elderton; and these sons: C. W. Shaffer of Elderton; L. J. of Niles, O.; and H. O. Shaffer, G.A. Shaffer and C.N. Shaffer, all of Elderton. He had resided in Elderton all of his life and for many years worked at the trade of carpentering, as a thresher and a coal miner. he was a member of Plumcreek Brethren Church.
